TWYs D2, D4- D6, R1- R4 status incorrect.

Jeppesen Airport Moving Map and A816 formatted data for cycle 2505, effective 15 May 2025, contain incorrect data for Nikola Tesla; Belgrade, Serbia (LYBE). NOTAMs A1726/25, A1731/25, A1733/25 effective from 00:00 [UTC] on 17 April 2025 to 23:59 [UTC] on 11 June 2025, introducing RWY 12R/30L construction works and affecting TWYs D2, D4-D6, R1-R6 status, were replaced by NOTAMs A2423/25, A2428/25, A2429/25, effective from 21 May 2025 to 23:59 [UTC] on 28 May 2025.

As a result, the following changes (effective 00:00 [UTC] on 29 May 2025) are not included in cycle 2505 data:

- TWYs D2, D4-D6 are open
- TWYs R1-R4 are open
- Construction Area on RWY 12R/30L is removed
